Forfeit time Note that if a player does not make their first move after **30 minutes** from the scheduled start time for that round then that game will be forfeited.

Half point bye A maximum of one only half point bye may be taken, for rounds 1 to 4 only.

Rating group prizes

Available for players with an ACF rating under 2000. Groups are determined by dividing all players with an ACF rating under 2000 by at most 6, for a minimum of 5 players per group. The value of each rating group prize and the number of rating groups will be based on the number of paying entries. These will be published following round three.

\$360 in total, **\$60** 1st in six rating groups (minimum 5 people per group).

A separate prize for anyone to win **\$ 60** Winner of the Biggest upset (judged by YewSze Lim)

Prizes to be shared equally in the event of a tie. In the event of a tie for the first to fifth places overall, the total prize money for the tied places will be shared between those tied players. For example, if there is a tie between two players for 1st place, those players will share a prize fund of \$600, and the next player(s) will receive (or share, in the event of a tie for 3rd place) the 3rd place prize money. Rating group winners determined by tie break procedure.
